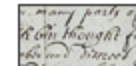

LIMITING YOUR RESULTS BY PERIODICAL TYPE

1. Each item on the results list will have a symbol (to the left of the title) that describes the periodical source (example graduation cap for scholarly journal.)
2. On the right hand side you can narrow your results by periodical type (examples, scholarly journal, newspaper, trade journal, or magazine.)
3. To narrow your result by periodical source click on the type of periodical source desired from the list on the right hand side.
4. View the next two slides to see this process.

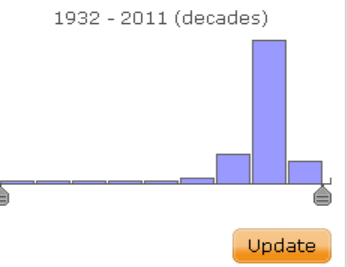

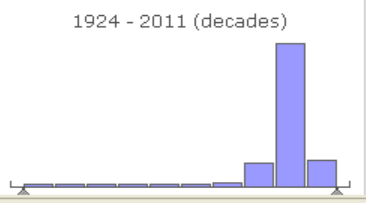

Abstract: Plaintiffs seeking compensation from the effects of global warming have encountered challenging legal barriers. Until 2009, courts consistently dismissed global warming suits as political questions or for lack of standing. In *Comer v. Murphy Oil USA*, property owners along the Mississippi Gulf coast sued oil and energy companies in nuisance for emitting greenhouse gases that contributed to global warming and added to the intensity of Hurricane Katrina, which damaged their property. In 2009, the Fifth Circuit surprisingly held that a class of private citizens could satisfy both standing and the political question doctrine in a global warming suit. However, after winding through a complex procedural pathway, that decision was ultimately vacated the following year following the denial of a writ of mandamus by the Supreme Court. *Comer's* companion case in the Second Circuit, *American Electric Power, Co.*, has been granted certiorari by the Supreme Court. That case should resolve the primary issues from *Comer*, namely standing and justiciability. It also marks the first opportunity for
